2008 YANYARRIE SHIRAZ

Tasting Notes:

“*Yanyarrie*” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured in the background of this elegant new label under *Neil Hahn Wines*.

This 2008 Shiraz displays an excellent deep red colour with beautiful purple hues. The bouquet shows strong blackberries with hints of sweet vanillin oak. The palate is rich and mouth filling with masses of blackberries and hints of black pepper leading to a very long finish with elegant tannins.

Wine Making:

These top quality low yielding fully ripened grapes were hand picked and then fermented and hand plunged in open vats before being matured in American oak barrels.

Cellaring:

Being a big wine, it will continue to develop and evolve over the next few years in bottle.

Food Suggestions:

This wine is the perfect accompaniment to a steak on the barbeque but would be equally at home with all but the hottest of spicy dishes.
