2006 YANYARRIE SHIRAZ

Tasting Notes:

“*Yanyarrie*” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured in the background of this elegant new label under *Neil Hahn Wines*.

This 2006 Shiraz displays an excellent deep red colour with beautiful purple hues. The bouquet shows strong blackberries and a hint of tobacco along with hints of sweet vanillin oak.

The palate is rich and mouth filling with masses of blackberries and hints of black pepper leading to a very long finish with elegant tannins.

Wine Making:

These top quality low yielding fully ripened grapes were hand picked and then fermented and hand plunged in open vats before being matured in American oak barrels.

Cellaring:

Being a big wine, it will continue to develop and evolve over the next few years in bottle.

Food Suggestions:

This wine is the perfect accompaniment to a steak on the barbeque but would be equally at home with all but the hottest of spicy dishes.
