2009 YANYARRIE SHIRAZ



Tasting Notes:

“*Yanyarrie*” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured in the background of this elegant label under *Neil Hahn Wines*.

This 2009 Shiraz displays a rich red colour with ample purple hues. The bouquet is redolent with blackberries as well as with hints of sweet vanillin oak. The palate is luscious and mouth filling with masses of blackberries and hints of black pepper leading to a very long elegant finish with fine grained tannins.

Wine Making:

These top quality low yielding fully ripened grapes were hand picked and then fermented and hand plunged in open vats before being matured in American oak barrels.

Cellaring:

Being a powerful wine, it will continue to develop and evolve over the next few years in bottle.

Food Suggestions:

This wine is the perfect accompaniment to a steak on the barbeque but would be equally at home with spicy meat dishes.
