2008 CATHARINA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Tasting Notes:

The “*Catharina*” is our flagship wine.

The 2008 Catharina Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits a deep rich red colour.

A very intense spicy, earthy aroma is evident, with underlying tones of blackberries and a smokey dusty oak aroma.

A soft generous palate with powerful berrylike fruits upfront and with a cinnamon, spicy finish. Strong, tight and clean finish with velvet like tannins. There is a good balance between oak and fruit giving this wine great potential for longer term cellaring.

Wine Making:

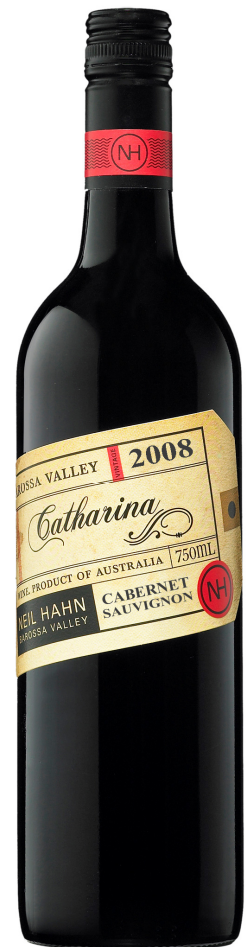
These top quality low yielding fully ripened grapes were hand picked and then fermented and hand plunged in open vats before being matured in American oak barrels.

Cellaring:

The cellaring potential of this wine is at least 8-10 years if stored in good conditions.

Food Suggestions:

Being a biggish wine it will go best with flavoursome meat dishes or with a cheese platter.
