2010 YANYARRIE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Tasting Notes:

“Yanyarrie” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured in the background of this elegant label under *Neil Hahn Wines*.

This 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon displays a deep rich purple red colour. There are delicate berry aromas on the bouquet along with a hint of vanillin.

A plummy mouth filling well rounded wine with oodles of flavour on the palate which is well balanced and has a long silky finish which lingers in the mouth.

Cellaring:

The cellaring potential of this wine is 5 – 7 years if stored in good conditions.

Food Suggestions:

Being a biggish wine it will go best with flavoursome meat dishes or with a cheese platter.
