Tasting Notes:

"Yanyarrie" is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured in the background of this elegant label under *Neil Hahn Wines*.

Pale straw in colour, this wine has fresh floral, musk and hints of citrus aromas.

The palate is fresh and approachable, with hints of lavender and limes giving a complex mouth-filling taste. The textured layers of flavours provide this wine with great length and structure. A very good food wine.

This wine will continue to develop over the next few years into a classic Barossa Riesling and is best enjoyed with seafood or white meat dishes.
