Description:



This 2012 Shiraz displays a good red colour with purple hues.



The bouquet is redolent with blackberries as well as with hints of sweet vanillin oak.



The palate is luscious and elegant with masses of fresh blackberries and hints of black pepper leading to a very long elegant finish with fine grained tannins.

Cellaring:

This wine will continue to develop and evolve in bottle, over the next few years.
