## 2012 YANYARRIE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*Tasting Notes:*



“*Yanyarrie*” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured in the background of this elegant label under *Neil Hahn Wines*.

This 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon displays a deep, rich, purple/red colour. There are pungent berry aromas on the bouquet along with a hint of oak.

A big, plummy, mouth-filling wine with mountains of flavour on the palate and it has a nice, grippy, tannic finish which lingers in the mouth, making it an ideal food wine.

### Cellaring:

The cellaring potential of this wine is 6 – 8 years if stored in good conditions.

### Food Suggestions:

Being a big wine it will go best with flavoursome meat dishes or with a cheese platter.
