Tasting Notes:

The “*Catharina*” is our flagship wine.

The 2003 Catharina Shiraz displays a big deep dark colour with restrained aromas and hints of black cherries, licorice and tobacco.

The wine has a big rich flavoursome palate, fully ripe fruit and grippy tannins on the finish.

Wine Making:

These top quality low yielding fully ripened grapes were hand picked and then fermented and hand plunged in open vats before being matured in American oak barrels.

Cellaring:

This wine is at its peak now in 2007 and will continue to cellar well for the next 3-5 years.

Food Suggestions:

Being a big wine it goes best with rich hearty meals or with a strong vintage cheese.
