



2005 YANYARRIE RIESLING

Tasting Notes:

“Yanyarrie” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured on the label.

This 2005 Riesling exhibits a pale gold colour with a crisp lime bouquet and hints of honey from bottle maturation.

The palate is still light and refreshing, this is attributed to the mineral acidity which is present in the wine. There is added complexity appearing from bottle maturation.

Cellaring:

This wine will continue to develop over the next 2-3 years and will then retain this level for several years thereafter.

Food Suggestions:

This wine can be enjoyed on its own as an aperitif or as an accompaniment with white meat dishes.
