



2007 YANYARRIE RIESLING

Tasting Notes:

“*Yanyarrie*” is aboriginal for the eagle feathers that are part of the Hahn Family Crest and are also featured on the label.

This 2005 Riesling exhibits a straw like colour. It has a very fragrant aromatic nose with hints of roses and limes.

There is a strong fruit component to this wine characterised by limes and lavender. This fruit is balanced beautifully by a crisp, steely acidity that gives this wine its elegance and persistence.

Cellaring:

This wine will continue to develop over the next few years into a classic Barossa Riesling.

This wine can be enjoyed as an aperitif or will go well with white meat dishes.
